Accommodation and food services



The accommodation and food services industry engages in providing short-term accommodation for visitors and/or meals, snacks, and beverages for consumption by customers both on and off-site. It includes sectors such as hotels, motels, cafes, pubs and restaurants.

By 2027-28, it is projected* that there will be:

212,484 people employed in accommodation and food services in Queensland
+7,674 additional people employed since 2023-24

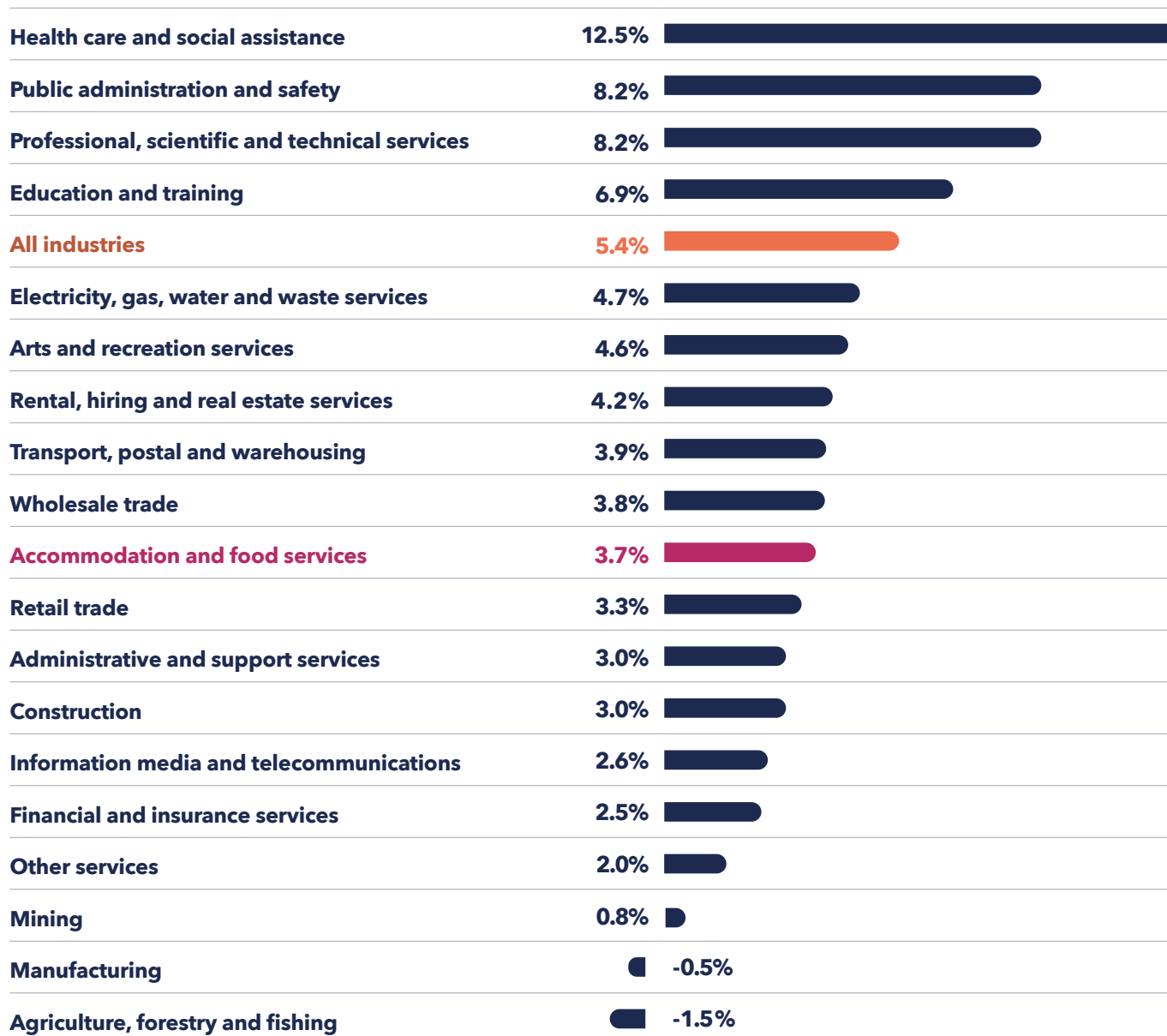
