

Anticipating Future Skills Series 5 Fast 5 Facts

Agriculture, forestry and fishing

By 2027-28:

- **Agriculture, forestry and fishing** is projected to decline by 1.5% to a workforce of 67,331.
- **This industry is expected** to see a reduction of 1,038 workers, an ongoing trend as production methods evolve and demand less labour.
- **3 In addition,** there will also be demand for replacement workers, meaning a total of 7,746 job openings.
- **The largest industry group,** sheep, beef cattle and grain farming employs 42.3% (28,478) of all workers in the industry and is projected to decline by 911 workers or 3.1%.
- 5 In Outback South, this industry accounts for 25.5% of regional employment, the largest proportion for a region in the state.
