

Anticipating Future Skills Series 5 Fast 5 Facts

Brisbane region

Between 2023-24 and 2027-28:

- **1 By 2027-28, Brisbane** is projected to experience the fifth-fastest increase in employment in Queensland and will comprise 35.2% of the state's workforce.
- **Employment in Brisbane** is projected to increase by 6.1% (61,348) to 1,074,452 workers.
- **Health care and social assistance** is the largest-employing and fastest-growing industry in the region and is projected to grow by 12.4% to 174,092 workers.
- **The region is a major hub** for professional, scientific and technical services, which is projected to grow by 8.3% to a workforce of 136,732, the second largest in the region.
- More workers will have bachelor degree level qualifications than any other qualification level. The largest occupation groups with this qualification are registered nurses, accountants, and software and applications programmers.
