



ANTICIPATING FUTURE SKILLS SERIES

Logan - Beaudesert region

The Logan - Beaudesert region is projected to experience above average employment growth by 2025-26. This is reflected in strong employment projections for many industries, including Health Care and Social Assistance, Professional, Scientific and Technical Services, and Education and Training.



By 2025-26, it is projected that there will be:

142,093 people employed in this region*

+12,119 additional workers since 2021-22

By 2025-26, Logan - Beaudesert is projected to experience the eighth fastest increase in employment in Queensland. It is projected to comprise 7.5% of the state's workforce.

* The regions used in this project are based on Statistical Area Level 4 (SA4) regions, as defined by the Australian Bureau of Statistics. There are 19 SA4s in Queensland; the five Brisbane SA4s have been combined in this report to take into account the larger natural labour market. Queensland - Outback SA4 has been disaggregated into its SA3 components. Data is based on Place of Work.
