



Rental, Hiring and Real Estate Services

The Rental, Hiring and Real Estate Services industry engages in renting, hiring, or otherwise allowing the use of tangible or intangible assets and related services such as real estate management.



By 2024-25, it is projected that there will be:

57,360 people employed in Rental, Hiring and Real Estate Services in Queensland

+6,505 additional people employed since 2020-21

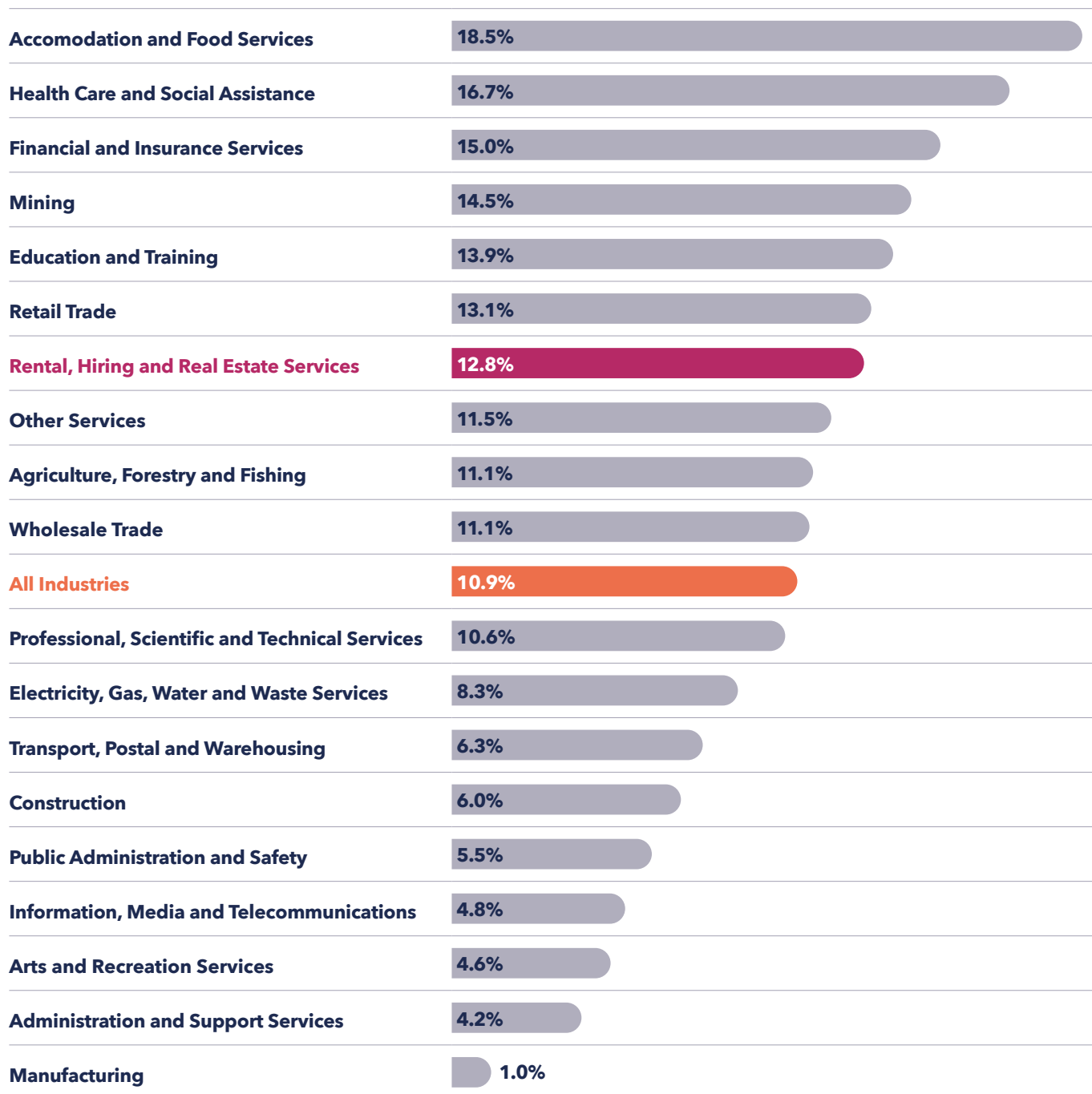

The Anticipating Future Skills project provides employment projections for Queensland between 2020-21 and 2024-25, enabling Queenslanders to identify job opportunities across industries, occupations and regions.

As these projections are high level and indicative, it is recommended that the focus be on employment trends rather than the numbers in isolation.

By 2024-25, employment in Rental, Hiring and Real Estate Services is projected to have grown at above the State average.
