Fast 5 Facts for schools

Schools use AFS to:

- 1 Link curriculum** to future employment opportunities. With 53 per cent of Queensland workers projected to hold a VET qualification, the education system is vital in preparing students to enter the labour market.
- 2 Enhance career advice** by understanding anticipated employment growth within their region. Schools can provide region specific advice to students during SETP and beyond.
- 3 Strengthen pathways** VET in schools offerings that are linked to growth industries will be critical in combating the state's youth unemployment figures and providing a strong link to the local labour market.
- 4 Inform parents** and caregivers on the breadth of occupations available to support students with future career planning and subject selection.
- 5 Highlight portability** of skills between occupations and industries. Individuals can expect to have multiple careers and different occupations during their lifetime.
